

## Conductor Anat Dor

Anat Dor-Margalit is the conductor and musical director of two municipal choirs in the city of Petach-Tikva, Israel: Neve Shir choir and Ron choir.

Anat started her music studies at the age of 6. She graduated from Lewinski College, majoring in choral conducting. She earned her Master's degree Cum Laude in Musical Education. She continues to take choral conduction courses and participates in Master Classes and workshops for conductors. She serves as an executive member of Harp and The Nightingale Foundation and the International Zimriya — a prestigious international choral festival that takes place in Israel, and a member of Hallel Choir Association.



Anat has held various roles in the Israeli Ministry of Education since 1979, such as supervising musical education in schools, coordinating special musical programs such as "Singing Schools" that focus on learning Israeli songs, creating and conducting concert programs with the Netanya Orchestra and the Israel Soloists Orchestra of Kfar-Saba, serving as mentor for music teachers on national and district levels, coordinating music studies in a religious school focused on musical education, and a devoted teacher herself.



Anat conducted the Neve Shir Women's Choir in the 49th International Choral Music Festival in Barcelona, Spain 2014. She led Neve Shir to a gold medal in the International Choir Games in Riga 2017, for its performance in a choir competition in the folklore category. And in December 2018 led the choir on a successful tour in Berlin, Germany.
